### **Juniors Attainment Structure**

Year 6 - In your final year with JLGB Juniors as you start thinking about your move to senior school, the transformation begins as we help grow children into young people. As young innovators, you'll get the chance to try things you haven't yet experienced, like leading games, helping at your local group and even trialling the Senior age level of JLGB.

**Year 5** - From getting your first taste of leadership to helping good causes through volunteering, as trailblazers, it's time for you to shine. You'll even get to camp under the stars (instead of in cabins) at camp as an extra reward!

**Year 4** – As you build in confidence after your first year with JLGB, lots of adventure still awaits you. By now, you may have even been on a Junior Spring or Summer Camp, or Junior Activity day.

**Year 3** – Juniors can now join JLGB from school year 3. This is your first step on the incredible JLGB journey as we light the spark and introduce you to a wonderful world of fun, friends, activities and adventure!

















## **JLGB Local Groups:**

### **Members Attainment Structure**

Year 13 - As a Senior Young Leader, you are expected to take on a bigger role within JLGB. In order to be promoted to this prestigious level, you will need to meet set criteria. You will be responsible for peer-mentoring and coaching of fellow Young Leaders at local groups, camps and events, and you may even get the chance to take on a managerial role within the Young Leaders Zone at camps. You can also put yourself forward to take on a national JLGB position.

**Year 12 –** In order to get promoted to Young Leader, you will need to meet set criteria and will then be able to take on specific roles at local groups, camps and events. You will be expected to mentor younger members and be able to help facilitate full evenings at JLGB groups. You will also have the chance to apply for different camp roles.

Year 11 - Entering school year 11, you will automatically be eligible to become an Acting Young Leader. This allows you into the Young Leaders Zone at camps as well as getting discounts on Israel Tour. You will be responsible for delivering Fuel sessions at local groups and helping to lead groups at camps. Accredited leadership development will help you to build your teamwork and communication skills.

Year 10 – An amazing transition, where you 'switch' from member to leader as you start your accredited leadership journey at training weekends. All in this year group will be eligible to take part in all Switch social events, including at camp. However, in order to be promoted fully to this level you will need to meet the criteria in order to gain additional roles and responsibilities.

Year 9 - Entering school year 9, you will automatically be eligible to be part of any activities designed for 'Overs' (school years 9 & 10) at local groups, camps and events. Year 9 is also the year you become eligible to take part in the Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE) which is highly subsidised for all JLGB local group members.

**Year 8 -** After a year of active involvement in your local JLGB group, you can be promoted to the next level. Extra rewards, badges and discounts can also be earned the more you give back to JLGB.

**Year 7 -** On reaching Senior School age, (or if you transitioned from JLGB Juniors), a new adventure begins for you! You are expected to partake in activities all designed to help teach you new skills and develop your sense of teamwork and community.
